#### East Asheville Academy

East Asheville Academy is a private child care and day care center right here in our neighborhood. Located in the heart of "downtown" Haw Creek, the center shares a building with Penny Cup Coffee and Creekside Tap House. The closing of Nurseryland Day Care (previously featured in this column), leaves EAA as only one of two community child care centers in Haw Creek, the other being the Haw Creek Elementary Head Start program.



The space had previously housed another day care center which came up for sale in 2007. This interested current owner Teresa Webb, who at the time had a small home-based day care center. She saw this opportunity to branch out and expand, knowing how much quality child care services are needed in the area. She had spent time as a child in the east Asheville

Oakley neighborhood and was familiar with the area. On January 1, 2008, Teresa opened East Asheville Academy and the business is still going strong and growing. <u>Read more...</u>

#### LITTLE FREE LIBRARIES - By Kathryn Liss




